
## key milestones

 Approved in early 2022, the National Programme of Official Statistics recognizes the need to improve data on alternative care services for children.


 For the first time, technical workshops were organized, supported by UNICEF Albania, joining NSO and State Social Service (responsible reporting entity).

 Methodology was agreed among parties, based on the national legislation and the TransMonEE guideline.

## future considerations

- Engaging Ministry of Health and Social Protection in the technical discussion to advocate for a separate module under social protection management information system.
