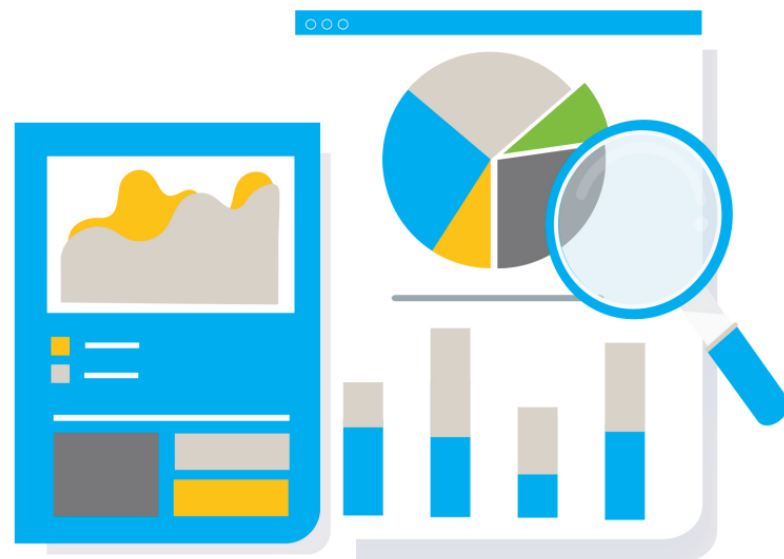


Statistics on alternative care services for children in Albania



key milestones



- Approved in early 2022, the National Programme of Official Statistics recognizes the need to improve data on alternative care services for children.
- For the first time, technical workshops were organized, supported by UNICEF Albania, joining NSO and State Social Service (responsible reporting entity).
- Methodology was agreed among parties, based on the national legislation and the TransMonEE guideline.

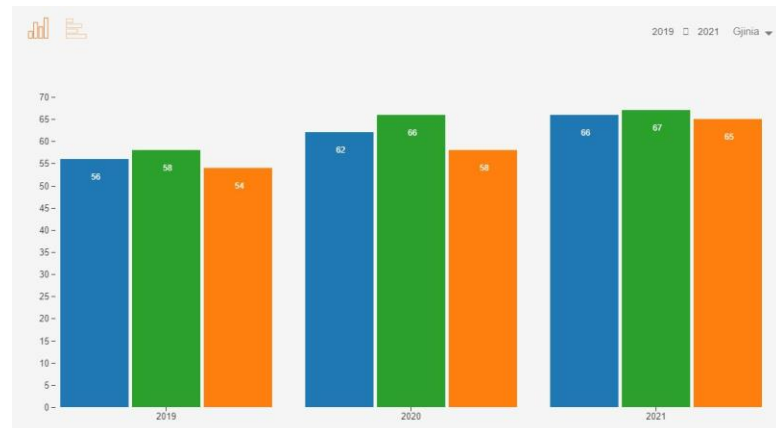
